As part of the curriculum, Zoology Department of Shanti Devi Arya Mahila College, Dinanagar organized a one-day visit for the students of BSc med 3rd year to Dr. Bharat Bhushan hospital, Dinanagar on 08/04/2021. This visit aimed at studying various diagnostic imaging techniques including ECG, X-rays, and ultrasound. The objective was to understand the principles, applications, and significance of each modality in modern medical diagnostics. During the visit, students were guided to different chambers by Mr. Balwinder and Dr. Bharat Bhushan introduced the students with various techniques.

Key learnings-

- At first, they were taken to ECG chamber to show ECG device and its working. An ECG measures the electrical activity of the heart over time. Interpretation of ECG readings was done by experienced cardiologists, illustrating the importance of skilled professionals in accurate diagnosis.
- After that they were guided to X-ray chamber where electromagnetic radiations are used to produce images of internal structures, particularly bones. They witnessed X-ray technicians positioning patients and capturing images and noted the importance of proper shielding and dose control to minimize radiation exposure, underscoring the priority of patient safety.

- Lastly, they were taken to Ultrasound chamber where ultrasound imaging utilizes sound waves to generate real-time images of organs and tissues. Students Observed obstetricians performing prenatal ultrasounds, providing expectant parents with visualizations of the foetus and monitoring foetal development.
- Discussed the versatility of ultrasound in diagnosing conditions like gallstones, liver diseases, and vascular abnormalities.

A two-day workshop on blood collection was organized by Zoology Department of Shanti Devi Arya Mahila College, Dinanagar in collaboration with Bharat Bhushan Hospital, Dinanagar on **15/09/21-16/09/21** at Hospital Lab. The workshop aimed to provide students with practical experience and knowledge regarding the process of blood collection, emphasizing safety protocols, techniques, and the significance of blood donation.

MR. Balwinder, a healthcare professional with expertise in phlebotomy conducted the workshop. 20 Students of BSc med 3rd year participated in the workshop.

Participants were provided with lab coats, gloves, and safety goggles to ensure adherence to hygiene and safety standards.

Workshop Activities:

Participants were divided into smaller groups, each led by a trained facilitator.

1. Facilitators demonstrated proper techniques for venipuncture and capillary puncture using anatomical models and simulation arms. They emphasized key steps such as selecting appropriate veins, applying tourniquets, cleaning the site, and inserting needles at the correct angle.

A session on Sterilization Techniques was organized by Zoology Department of Shanti Devi Arya Mahila College, Dinanagar in collaboration with Bharat Bhushan Hospital, Dinanagar on **26/04/23**. This session aimed to familiarize participants with different sterilization techniques to eliminate or deactivate all forms of microbial life during laboratory work. Dr. Shardha was the key note speaker. 20 students from BSc medical 3rd year attended the workshop along with Mrs. Sunita Verma (HOD Zoology Department).

Objective:

The primary objective of the activity was to provide participants with practical experience in implementing sterilization techniques and understanding their importance in ensuring safety and quality in different environments.

Materials and Methods:

1. Autoclave: Participants were introduced to autoclaving, a widely used method that employs high pressure and steam to sterilize equipment and materials. They learned how to properly load the autoclave, set the parameters, and monitor the sterilization process.
2. Chemical Sterilization: Different chemical agents such as ethylene oxide and hydrogen peroxide were demonstrated for sterilizing medical instruments and

laboratory equipment. Safety precautions and proper handling of chemicals were emphasized.

3. Dry Heat Sterilization: Participants were introduced to dry heat sterilization techniques, which involve the use of hot air ovens. They learned about the temperature and duration required to achieve sterilization without moisture.
