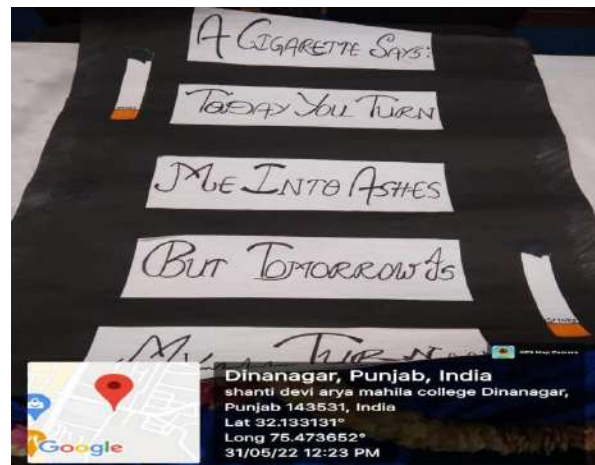
24 May 2022

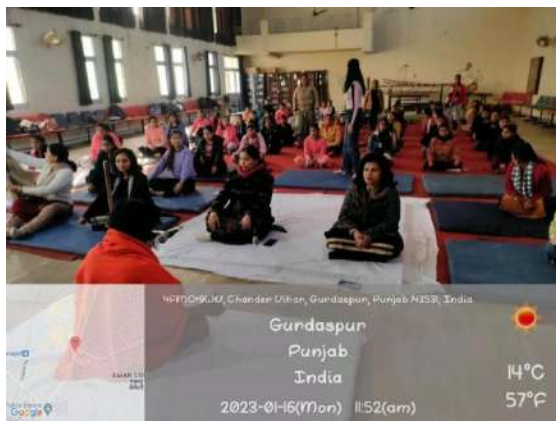




On 6th day of 7 Days Special NSS Camp

this camp .Swami ji was honoured by Principal Madam and program officers by presenting a shawl & souvenir of the college.

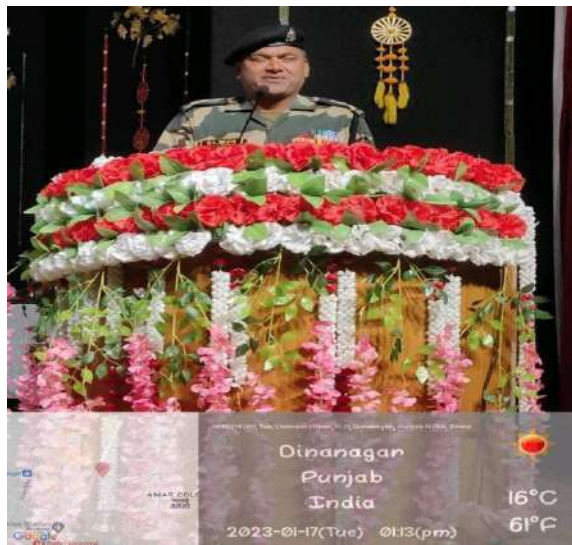


On 7th Day Closing Ceremony of 7 Days Special NSS Camp

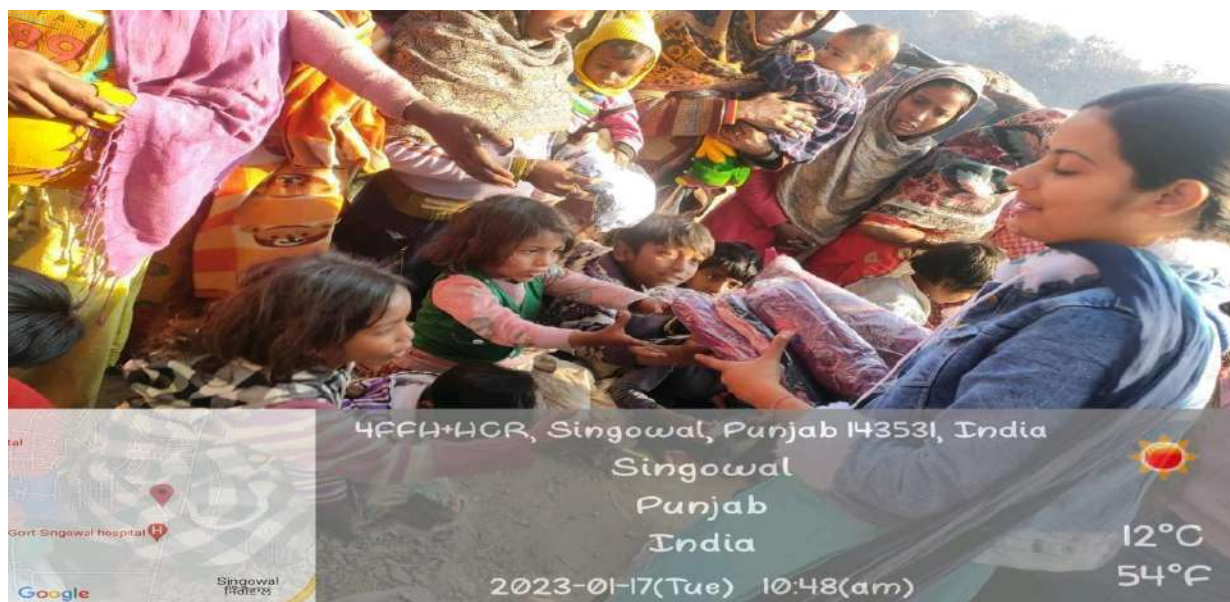

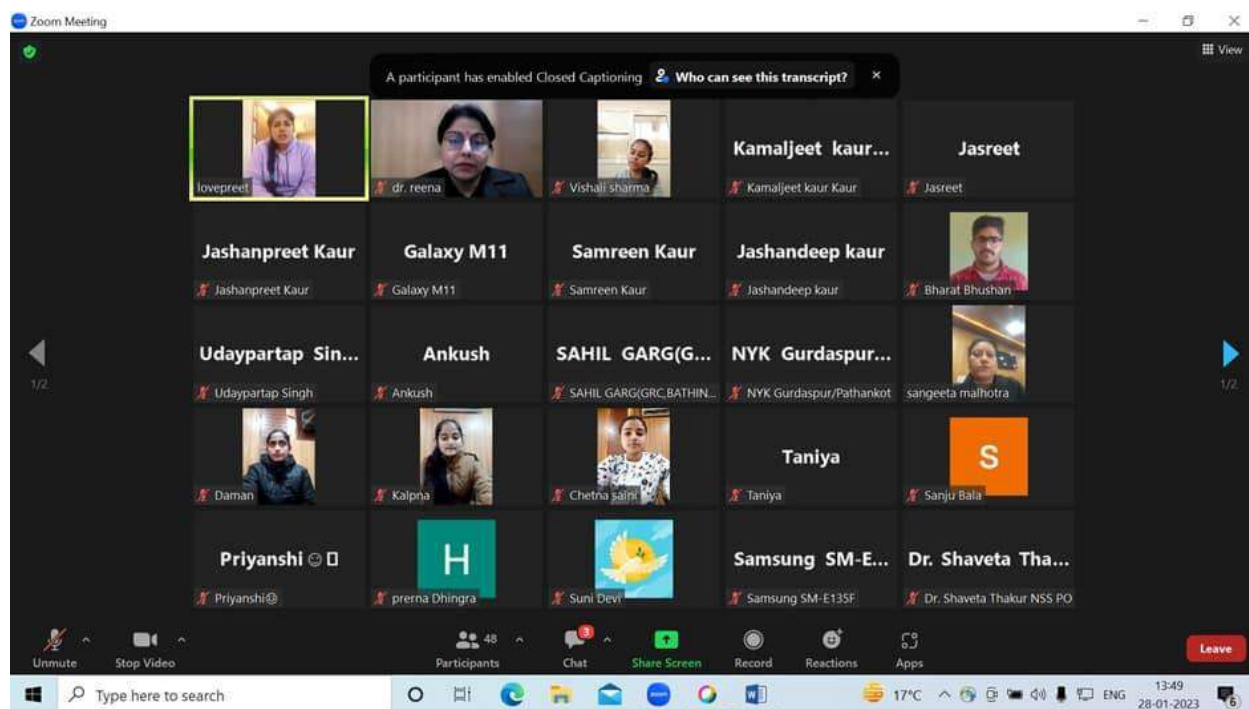

26 Apr 2023

Science, EBSB club and NSS department of Shanti Devi Arya Mahila College Dinanagar, under the able guidance of Principal Dr. Reena Talwar, organised a Seminar on 26th April 2023 on the topics: **Anaemia and Oral Health Hygiene**. Dr. Kusum and Dr. Sukhwinder Kumar were Resource Persons from department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab, CHC Singawal. Haemoglobin estimation camp was also organized during this day with the help of Pharmacist Smt. Nirmal and Lab technician Mr. Rashpal Singh. These events were organized under Anemia Mukta Bharat Abhiyan. Principal Dr. Reena Talwar told that the Anemia Mukta Bharat (AMB) strategy was launched in 2018 to reduce prevalence of Anemia all over India. It is an initiative of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) & United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF).

Dr. Kusum threw light upon various causes and cure of Anemia. She told that Anemia is caused by various nutritional and non-nutritional factors, the most prominent of which is iron deficiency. She stressed on three vital strategies i.e., promotion of regular consumption of foods rich in iron, provisions of iron and folate supplements in the form of tablets to the high risk groups, and identification and treatment of severely anemic cases.

Dr. Sukhwinder Kumar told that Oral health is the condition of the mouth, teeth, and orofacial structures that enable individuals to perform essential functions such as speaking, breathing and eating. Various modifiable risk factors, such as food consumption rich in sugar, poor oral hygiene, tobacco and alcohol use, lead to oral disorders. He made the students aware about various tips and techniques on how to brush properly and also gave instructions about the usage of floss and mouthwash for oral hygiene.


21 Jun 2023

01 Dec 2023

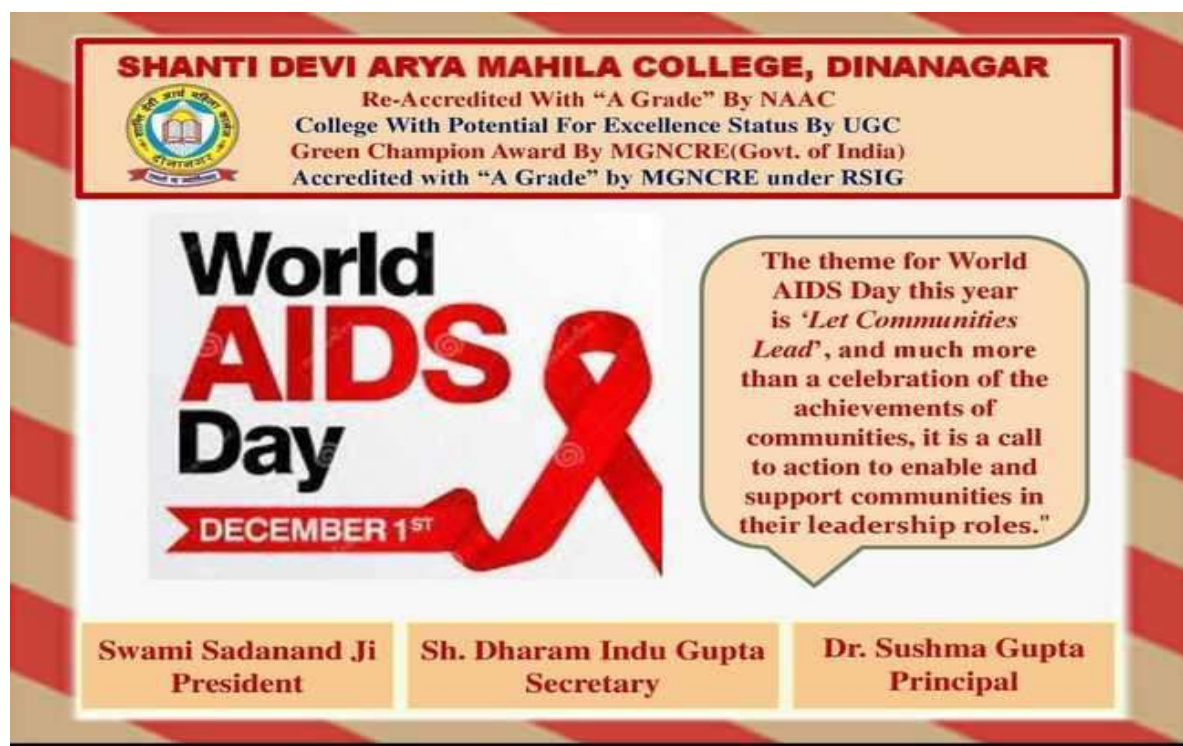

Commencing the event, Principal Madam threw light upon the theme which was "Empowering Lives, Embracing Progress: Equitable and Accessible Thalassaemia Treatment for All".

She told that Thalassaemia is an inherited (i.e., passed from parents to children through genes) blood disorder caused when the body doesn't make enough of a protein called hemoglobin, an important part of red blood cells. She added that there are two types of thalassemsias due to mutation in genes i.e., Alpha thalassaemia: when a gene or genes related to the alpha globin protein are mutated and Beta thalassaemia: when similar gene defects affect production of the beta globin protein. Mrs. Sunita Verma (EBSB Coordinator) made the students aware about the difference between thalassaemia minor and major. She added that mutation in one gene causes

thalassemia minor causing mild signs and symptoms of anaemia and mutation in two genes cause thalassemia major, or Cooley anemia leading to moderate to severe signs and symptoms of anaemia. She told that the Primary prevention for thalassemia focuses on education and genetic counseling. These measures can help to prevent the birth of patients with thalassemia. She gave awareness by telling that Thalassemia is a treatable disorder that can be well-managed with blood transfusions, chelation therapy and Bone marrow transplantation. Principal Madam appreciated the efforts of said departments for successful organisation of the event. Dr. Parveen Saini, Dr. Sonam Gupta, Mr. Mohit Agarwal, Mrs. Shelika were also present to enhance the grace of the occasion.
